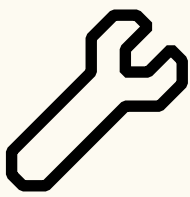
Before pleading guilty at a military court-martial, discuss potential collateral consequences with a military defense lawyer.



Loss of military benefits



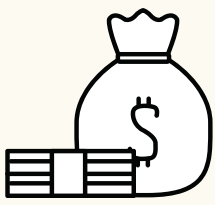
Federal criminal record



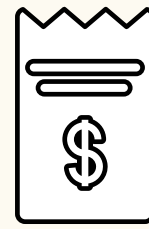
Difficulty obtaining employment



Loss of the ability to own or possess firearms



Ineligible for some bank loans & college financial aid



Loss of VA disability & unemployment benefits



Prohibitions on working with children



Ineligible to provide foster care to family



Ineligible for public benefits, such as food stamps



Ineligible for certain occupations & business licenses
