Loss of military benefits



Difficulty obtaining employment



Ineligible for some bank loans & college financial aid



Prohibitions on working with children



Ineligible for public benefits, such as food stamps



Federal criminal record



Loss of the ability to own or possess firearms



Loss of VA disability & unemployment benefits



Ineligible to provide foster care to family



Ineligible for certain occupations & business licenses
